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Notice Concerning Borrowing of Funds

Activia Properties Inc. (“API”) announces that it decided to borrow funds (the “Borrowing”) today. Details are as follows:

I. Borrowings

1. Details of the borrowing

(Note 2) Interest rate of the borrowing will be announced upon the determination.

(Note 3) The interest payment will be made on June 30, 2025 and the last days of June and December in each year thereafter as well as on the due date of the principal. (If an interest payment date is a non-business day, it shall be the following business day. If such day falls in the following month, it shall be the immediately preceding business day.)

2. Reasons for the borrowing

API will use the funds from the borrowings to redeem a long-term borrowing of 6 billion yen (the “Existing Long-term Borrowing”) with a due date of December 13, 2024. For the details of the Existing Long-term Borrowings, please refer to “Notice Concerning Borrowings of Funds” released on June 6, 2016.

3. Amount, use and schedule of disbursement of funds to be raised

(Note 1) Long-term debt ratio is the ratio of the outstanding long-term borrowings (including the long-term borrowings to be repaid within one year) and investment corporation bonds (including the investment corporation bonds to be

redeemed within one year) to the total of outstanding interest-bearing debt.

- (Note 2) Long-term debt ratio (excluding the long-term borrowings to be repaid and investment corporation bonds to be redeemed within one year) is the ratio of the outstanding long-term borrowings (excluding the long-term borrowings to be repaid within one year) and investment corporation bonds (excluding the investment corporation bonds to be redeemed within one year) to the total of outstanding interest-bearing debt.
- (Note 3) Fixed interest ratio is the ratio of the total of outstanding interest-bearing debt with fixed interest rates to the total of outstanding interest-bearing debt. The total of outstanding interest-bearing debt with fixed interest rates includes debts whose interest rates were converted into fixed interest rates by interest rate swap agreements.
- (Note 4) Figures are rounded to the first decimal place.

III. Other

Regarding the risks related to the repayment of the Borrowing, there are no significant changes in the “Investment Risk” section of the securities report submitted on August 27, 2024.
